CENTENARY OF FATIMA APPARITIONS

First visit of the Angel

In 1916, as if in preparation for the Visits of Our Lady, the three children were graced with three visits by an Angel. The children were tending their sheep on the east side of the Cabeço, (a small hill about 5 minutes' walk from their village called Aljustrel, which is a hamlet of Fatima), when a strong wind began to shake the trees. A figure appeared above the olive trees and as it came closer Lucy describes: "It was a young man, about fourteen ... whiter than snow, transparent as crystal when the sun shines through it, and of great beauty."

The young man spoke: "Do not be afraid! I am the Angel of Peace. Pray with me."

Kneeling on the ground, he bowed down until his forehead reached the ground. The children did the same. Then he led them in this prayer three times: "My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I ask pardon of Thee for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee!"

3rd Sunday of Easter April 30, 2017

"Cry out with joy to God, all the earth; O sing to the glory of his name. O render him glorious praise, alleluia."

1st Reading: Acts 2.14,22b-28

This address of St Peter is the first of the missionary discourses. Peter proposes in short summary the name, work, death, and resurrection of our Lord. The statement has one main clause: "You killed (our Lord)...But God raised him (to life)."

2nd Reading: 1 Pet. 1.17-21

As followers of Jesus we have been ransomed by his blood. Through him we are believers in God who raised Jesus from the dead. Our faith and hope are in him.

Gospel: Lk. 24.13-35

Two disciples who do not recognize Jesus walk with him. Cleopas tells about Jesus- his miracles, passion, death and resurrection, and the hope Israel had in him. Finally, in the breaking of bread they see that Jesus is with them, truly risen.
