30th Sunday In Ordinary Time October 29, 2017

"Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice; turn to the Lord and his strength; constantly seek his face".

First Reading: Ex. 22.21-27

The Lord warns us against oppressing foreigners or harming widows or orphans. Consideration for the poor and needy should be a prime concern.

Second Reading: 1 Thess. 1.5c-10

The Thessalonians. Received the word of the Lord in site of great hardships. They then became model Christians to their neighbours. They turned from idols to worship the true God.

Gospel Mt. 22.34-40

Jesus tells the lawyer that the greatest of all the commandments is love - to love God above all else and one's neighbour as oneself. This sums up the whole law.
