Second Reading: 1 Thess. 4.13-18

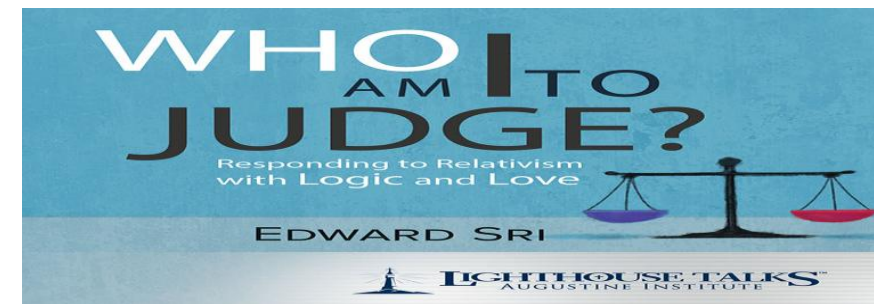
Those who die believing in Jesus will rise with him. They will in the judgement rise first to enjoy God's life with Jesus.
