Second Reading: 1 Thess. 5.1-6

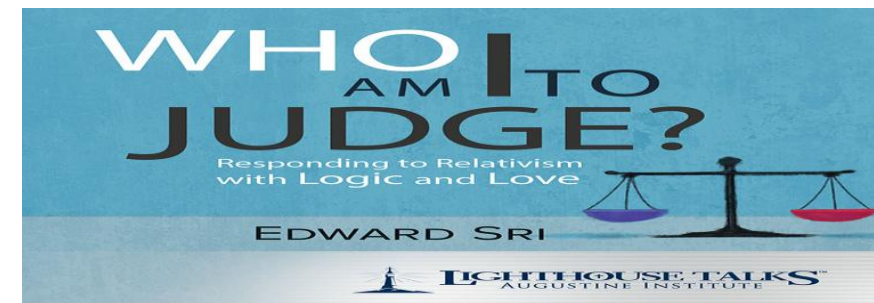
The day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. It will be sudden. There will be no escape.
