First Reading: 1 Sam 3.3b-10

Second Reading: 1 Cor. 6.13c

The body is made for the Lord. With the price of the cross Jesus redeemed all humanity. The Holy Spirit dwells within each person.

Gospel Jn. 1.35-42

It was John the Baptist's purpose to point out Jesus, the Messiah. Andrew and his companion go with Jesus. Andrew summons Peter. Jesus identifies Peter and gives him a new name.
