It is hoped that many devotees of Our Lady will not be content with the minimum required and will not pass up opportunities of voluntary mortification, placing in the hands of Our Lady the fruits of the little trials, frustrations and irritations of each day accepted with patience and resignation.

It was in this same spirit that the Angel spoke to the children in 1916: "Offer up everything in your power as a sacrifice to the Lord in reparation for the sins by which He is offended, and in supplication for the conversion of sinners . . . More than all else, accept and bear with resignation the sufferings that God may send you.

13th Sunday In Ordinary Time July 2, 2017

"All peoples, clap your hands. Cry to God, with shouts of joy!"

First reading 2 Kgs. 4.8-12a

The woman received Elisha into her home because she knew he was "a holy man of God," a preacher, which means in the Bible "a bearer of God's word." We should accept our priest as such, especially when listening to the homily.

Second reading Rom. 6.3-4

Through the waters of baptism we rise to a new life of Grace in Jesus who was buried and came back to life. In the same way we who were dead to sin become alive for God in Jesus.

Gospel Mt. 10.37-42

Jesus speaks of the supreme commandment of God. Those who do not carry their cross for Jesus are not worthy of him. Jesus also describes the tremendous rewards for those who show love for him and for others.

RECEIVING THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

When we gather together in the church for the celebration of the Holy Eucharistic, it is our response to Jesus' invitation to "Do this in memory of me". Therefore let us make sure that we are well disposed to celebrate the Holy Eucharist and partake in the Eucharistic Meal. This means that besides being in a state of grace, we also have the right motive and behaviour while receiving the body and blood of Christ. Therefore, it will be good to remind ourselves of the following when receiving the Holy Communion.

1. No gum in the mouth.
2. When the communion minister says, "The Body/ Blood of Christ", say "Amen" when before receiving the body/blood in the hand,
3. The proper way to receive the Host in the hand is to place one hand flat on top of the other so that the open palm is facing upward. (Saint John Chrysostom described this beautiful gesture as making of your hands a throne for the King of Kings.) It is not appropriate to receive the Host by taking it with two fingers (as if "plucking" or "pinching" or "grabbing") from the Minister of Communion.
4. Make sure that the hands are clean enough to receive the body of Christ. No gloves or pulled sleeves covering the hands.
5. Bow before the chalice if not receiving the precious blood.
